

DISRUPTION OF TRAFFIC FROM 20 MAY 2019

We would like to notify you that transport for the next round of wind farms are scheduled to start on 20 May 2019.

The tower sections will be supplied from the GRI factory in Atlantis and the rest of the components will be received at the port of Saldanha.

The 1st project will be the Perdekraal wind farm situated near Touws River and consist of 48 wind turbine generators which is made up of 10 components each.

The loads will only be transported on week days and will not pass through any towns during peak hours, public holidays or embargo periods.

Most of the loads will be escorted by the Provincial Traffic Department, while other smaller loads will be allowed to travel with private escorts.

Absolute Wind (the transporter) will send out daily communications of the loads planned to be transported the following day.

The map below illustrates the main route that the loads will follow.
