

## NOTICE TO ALL TELEVISION OWNERS

Dear Client

Digital TV and Radio signal switch

South Africa is currently switching from analogue to digital TV and radio broadcast. In order for your television to receive and decode the digital signal, you need a decoder or STB.

If you are not in possession of a decoder then you will not be able to receive any television channels in the future.

These decoders will be available soon at all major stores and retailers.

### **Disadvantaged households/families.**

The government realizes that many needy or less privileged families will hardly be able to afford these decoders. For this reason, the state has decided to subsidize 100% of these STBs to eligible less privileged families / households.

To qualify for the subsidization of this decoder, you must meet the following requirements:

1. You must be a South African citizen.
2. You must be in possession of a functioning TV set.
3. Your combined family income must not exceed R3200.00 per month.

If you qualify please visit your nearest Post Office with the **following documents**:

- Your valid identity document or card
- Your television license card/statement or declaration/affidavit from the SAPS as proof of a functioning television
- Proof of combined monthly income e.g. salary advice or SASSA statement where your details appear
- Proof of residential address e.g. municipal or shop account not older than three months.

### **Important:**

The above mentioned documents or certified copies thereof **MUST** accompany/be attached to your application.
